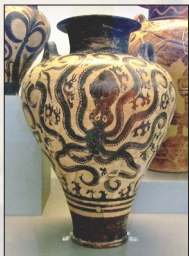

This large three-handled amphora features three octopuses with swirling tentacles amidst floating seaweed. It is a Mycenaean imitation of Minoan Marine Style, excavated from the Mycenaean cemetery of Argive Prosymna, Tomb 2, and in the collection of the Athens Archaeological Museum.
